A new order of REDXA shirts has been made and will be available shortly.



Bob K6QXY reports that the VHF community now feels that they have discovered a new propagation mode, calling it ESSSP for Equatorial Summer Solstice short path propagation. (Of course, in the southern hemisphere, it would be called EWSSP for Winter.)



It appears that this mode is related to the summer Sporadic E (Es) but links into a TransEquatorial (TE) mode. Part of the proof of this new mode was a QSO Bob made with ZL3NW and ZL1RS. Bob will certainly be investigating this more this winter.


