I want to thank the members that participated in the 10 Meter contest. It appears we have more than 12 logs submitted, which puts us in the Medium (<50 logs) club category. I believe this is the first time REDXA has competed as a club other than Field Day and CQP. We might consider the November Sweepstakes as an additional club competition, if the NCCC continues to choose not to compete in it.

Friday night's conditions for the 10 Meter contest were somewhat of a Worked All REDXA, with N6OJ, N6ZFO, K6JS, K6SRZ, KE6LPO, N6GY, K6LRN, N6YEU all on the air.

Bill, N6ZFO found "10m to be challenging, but with fairly good results. There was an interesting mix of F2, Sporadic E and backscatter QSO's; heard some meteor pings, but can't say any Q's resulted. Unable to get Yagi at its full height, so just about 20 feet AGL."

Most members had similar conditions on Saturday with apparent pipelines to OH, MI, FL and NC and only a handful of 7's and 0's. DX would occasionally come out of the noise with QSO's to D4, ZS,V5 and EA8. We also had good signals from the Caribbean and Central and South America.

Sunday saw a good run of JA's and Oceania before the end of the contest.

SUGAR AND SPICE COOKIES

3/4 cups room temp. unsalted butter

1 cup of sugar

1 egg

1 tsp vanilla

1/4 cup of molasses

2 cups of flour

2 tsp of baking soda

1/4 tsp Salt

1 tsp cinnamon

3/4 tsp ground cloves

3/4 tsp ginger

1/2 cup raw sugar for rolling the cookies

Instructions

Pre-heat oven to 350

Cream butter and sugar, add egg, vanilla then molasses.

Sift together dry ingredients and add to the butter mixture until just combined.

Using a cookie scoop form small balls and roll in sugar.

Bake on Silpat liners or parchment paper for 10-12 minutes, one sheet at a time.

Let cool on cookie sheets for about 5 minutes then transfer to a cooling rack.

By far, the best cookies for contesting I ever enjoyed!


