REDXA/MARS Field Day 2016

As many of you already know, after several wonderful years doing our joint Field Day effort with the folks at the Marin Amateur Radio Society, our traditional venue, the Marin Rod & Gun Club gave us the 'heave-ho' just weeks before this year's event. This was not a result of anything we did wrong, but rather that they got an offer for a lot of money to rent the area to a commercial business entity to store large vehicles that would preclude our use of the property.

This set off a panicked search for a property that would give us the land to deploy our antennas, not too far from Marin or southern Sonoma county, that was easily accessible 24/7, that looked like it had at least fair propagation to the east with no substantial man-made noise, reasonably nice microclimate and not attract too many 'looky-loos'. That's a lot of criteria, and with the value and scarcity of real estate in the region, and given the last-minute nature of the problem, finding a venue was a challenge!

After brainstorming ideas and combing Google Earth for hours, we finally had a breakthrough. An old friend of Alan, K6SRZ, has a ranch that is 'rentable' by entities such as ours for events. There is a nicely refurbished barn for our equipment and operations area, plenty of room for antennas and parking and it's conveniently located right on the Sonoma-Marin border. All the information about the dates and the location, along with the Power-Point I showed at our May meeting is on the REDXA website.

At this month's meeting, I will make a short presentation with pictures and plans for the event and I can answer any questions that any of you may have. I hope to see you all at this year's Field Day event, the weekend of June 24-26!
